REGISTRATION FOR GAMES

- runs until Wednesday 25 June until 14:00;
- register at the accommodation facility where you are staying (participants that are not using Emil Open accommodation register will register from 24 June (14:00-20:00) to 25 June (8:00-14:00) at the Palacký Hotel (Kolejní 2, 612 00 Brno);
- the accommodation coordinator will give you all the essential information and participation packages for the whole team. In the package you will find accreditation cards for each member of the team (in case of an approved change of members, a new accreditation will be issued) and gifts from partners. Please bring your t-shirts (if you do not have uniform club clothing) to the opening ceremony;
- when registering we do not accept any changes in your team (number of people, replacement of
 one person by another, change of sport), so your team must come to the games in the same
 composition as entered in the system!
- if you have not sent scanned signed liability and photo consents for your entire team (including staff), it is requested that you provide these documents at registration! Without these documents, you will not be able to participate in the games!

TRANSPORT

EMIL OPEN - ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

The transportation coordinator has contacted you and requsted filling in the transportation form. Here you have filled in the complete transport information, whether you need a **transfer from the arrival point** (e.g. from the main train or bus station) **to your accommodation or transport to the sports ground**. If you have not confirmed the need for a transfer by the deadline, you will automatically be deemed to have arranged the transfer yourself.

If you have confirmed the need for a transfer with the transport coordinator, **the coordinator** will be **waiting for** you at the time of your arrival. You will recognize him by the sign with the inscription EMIL OPEN. The coordinator will take you to the bus stop, which will take you to your accommodation. Transportation will be by shuttle.

An accommodation coordinator will be waiting for you in all accommodation complexes.

Shuttle and bus times to your accommodation are arranged according to the times you have indicated in the form. If your actual arrival time differs from the time indicated in the form, please report it immediately to transport@emilopen.cz . The organizer does not guarantee the transport in case of incorrect information in the registration form or non-communicating the delays.

For international participants, we strongly recommend securing ROAMING for seamless online communication via WhatsApp.

You will again be able to use one of the shuttle buses (from the dormitories to the departure point) to get back home from Emil Open (at times when most of you are leaving). Please contact the transport coordinator if you wish to use this option. Alternatively, you can take individual public transport for free (with your accreditation card).

TRANSPORT DURING THE GAMES

Transfers to and from the sports venues and to the organised accompanying programme from the accommodation will be arranged by the organiser in cooperation with the DPMB. Information on departure times will be placed on the information stands (EMIL POINT) of each accommodation facility the evening before. Coordinators will also be available for transfers.

During the entire duration of the Games you will also have **free transport by public transport in Brno**, which you can use for your individual programme. In the event of an inspection, you must present your accreditation card. In case of non-acceptance of this card, please contact the transport coordinator immediately.

ACCOMMODATION

You will find one information point in each building of the university halls of residence, which will be visibly marked with the Emil Open logo. There will be coordinators present on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Throughout the Games, our volunteers will be at the reception desk of the A02 building - Hotel Palacký, where they will assist you with various situations and provide you with the necessary information about the races, transport, the accompanying program, etc.

These coordinators will register you for the games upon arrival, provide you with accreditation cards and participation packages, and help you register for accommodation. Non-accommodated participants will pick up their accreditation cards and participation packages at the dormitories Pod Palackého vrchem (reception in building A02 - Hotel Palacký) on Tuesday 24th June from 2 pm to 8 pm or on Wednesday 25th June until 2 pm. In case you have reported the submission of signed documents at registration, the submission will be required.

Warning! Please observe check-in and check-out times

Any unauthorised change of team members may result in the person(s) not being accommodated. In the event that there is an opportunity to accommodate that person not previously registered in the system, full payment for both accommodation and meals will be required.

- check-in on Tuesday 24.6 (14-20), Wednesday 25.6 until 14:00, check-out until 10:00 on the day of departure;
- Information point will be located in each block A02, A04 and A05 at the reception;
- coordinators will be present at the Emil point in building A02 (Hotel) during the whole games
- catering is provided on the ground floor of the building. Meals will always be served on presentation of the accreditation you will receive when you register for accommodation.
- breakfast will be served from 7:00 to 9:00, dinner from 18:00 to 20:00, on Friday 27.6. from 18:20 at the Athletic Stadium
- Wi-Fi is not provided;
- toiletries and towels are not included in dormitory rooms;
- Parking is available in the public car park at the dormitory;
- there will be a room in the dormitory for storing sports and compensatory aids. A key to the room will be available from the coordinator;

On Saturday, after check-out, participants who are taking part in the accompanying program can drop off their luggage at the reception of the AO2 building - Hotel Palacký. Volunteers will be present throughout the day to take care of their storage.

BOARD

The organizer provides **free** meals for the participants during the entire duration of the games.


Breakfast and dinner are provided in the college canteen, building A02, for participants who have registered for meals in their application form;

- Catering is provided in two places, the Canteen and the Mozzarella Pizzeria, both located on the ground floor of the building. Please pay attention to the team's assignment to the dining rooms and the schedule that will be on the information board at each information booth. Meals will always be served upon presentation of your accreditation and meal vouchers, which you will receive at check-in;
- on the day of your arrival you start with dinner, on the day of your departure you end with breakfast;

- The portions correspond to the food order in the participant's registration form! Incorrectly filled in application form and therefore unreported meal portion will not be taken into account.
 Participant identification and a meal ticket are required at the time the meal is served;
 - Every registered participant of the Games will receive a snack in the form of a packet (if they have declared it in the registration form):
 - On Thursdays and Fridays, the packages will be delivered directly to the sports ground you are registered for and handed out between 11:30 and 12:30 in the designated area;
 - on Wednesday (for those staying in the dormitories from Tuesday) you can pick up your packages after breakfast at the information booth in the Palacký Hotel (building AO2).
 - Lunch packages are NOT provided on Saturday.
- There will be a name check by volunteers when breakfast and dinner are served (dinners reported but not taken will be charged later).
- We urge you to keep to the times in the catering schedule, because of the queues.
- Drinking water is available at all sports venues we highly recommend bringing your own water bottles.

SUMMARY/IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Each participant will be given an accreditation card when registering for the games, which will take place at the dormitories upon arrival. Non-housed participants will pick up their accreditation and participation packages at the dormitories Pod Palackého vrchem (reception in building AO2 Hotel Palacký) on Tuesday 24th June from 2 pm to 8 pm or on Wednesday 25th June until 2 pm.
- You must carry your accreditation card with you at all times during the Games and identify yourself with it at the dormitories, sports venues and when food is served. You can also use it during the accompanying programme and during transport.
- Each delegation must send a representative to the technical meeting on 25 June at 18:30 (more in the Sports section) who will take over all the necessary information. If you are the only accompanying athlete, the athlete(s) may accompany you.
- Please note that the departure from the technical meeting to the accommodation will take place at 19:30, the bus will be parked on the main road in front of the hotel, so we recommend to take this into account and arrive at the departure point in advance
- In addition to the transport organised by us, you can use public transport within the city of Brno for free on the basis of your registration card. To find connections, we recommend the <u>IDOS</u> app.
- Breakfast and dinner are served at the accommodation.
- Lunch snacks will only be given out on June 26 and 27 at the athletic field where you are registered, from 11:30 am 12:30 pm in a designated area.
- Lunch snacks will be issued on 25.6. at the information stand in the Palacký Hotel (building A02)
 MUST BE PICKED UP immediately after breakfast.
- **The accommodation coordinators** will deal with your requests and provide you with all information regarding accommodation, transport, sports venues and the accompanying programme.
- For the opening ceremony, which will take place on Náměstí Svobody, participants of each organization should wear the same clothing either Emil Open T-shirts or uniform clothing of the club (T-shirt, sweatshirt, etc.). If you wish, it is also possible to bring a banner/banner with the name of the delegation/club or its flag (ATTENTION, not the national flag).
 - Afterwards your arrival on Česká stop, we ask you to look for the person with your country's flag and line up behind him/her (you will help us with the organization of the opening parade)
- For the safe course of the games it is necessary to observe: the rules of this manual, traffic regulations of the Czech Republic, rules of conduct at sports grounds and other venues.





- **Liability** the organizer is not liable for injuries to athletes, their escorts or for accidents, illnesses, loss of objects and damage to them. Each delegation shall send a signed "Declaration of Responsibility" and "GDPR" to the organizer by 24 June by email and, in case of non-compliance with this deadline, submit it at the Games registration. Without it, participation in the Games is not possible!
- A medic/lifeguard will be available at each sports field during the games.
- Each delegation is responsible for its own insurance.
- Within the sports hall and gymnasium on the Campus it will be possible to use showers for wheelchair users (chairs)

HEALTH SERVICE

- A medic is present at every sports field throughout the event, and a lifeguard is present at the pools. The site is visibly marked with a red cross and volunteers and organisers are able to guide you to the site immediately.
- Important numbers in case of emergency:
 - Emergency line of the integrated rescue system = 112
 - o Police of the Czech Republic = 158
 - Ambulance service = 155
 - o Fire Brigade of the Czech Republic = 150

SAFETY

- It is important to observe the rules of the hostels and sports grounds
- Paramedic:
 - o in dormitories if necessary, contact the reception or the coordinator at the info desk,
 - o at the sports ground at a marked place, marked with a red cross
- Health problem the escort/leader of the delegation is obliged to report to the medic
- Each participant is obliged to consider the risk and arrange individual insurance
- Due to the expected hot weather, we recommend headwear, sunscreen and drinking regimen.





SPORTS PART OF THE GAMES



GENERAL AND TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- 1. Official language Czech, English
- 2. Target group young people with disabilities (physical, visual, hearing, mental and combined disabilities); aged from 10 to 26 years (competitor must be of this age on at least one day from 1.1.2025 to 31.12.2025); exceptions are participants of the V4 Team Games Emil Open
- 3. Registration:
 - **3.1.** applications online via summer.emilopen.cz/entries
 - **3.2. participant** on the day of arrival at the specified place. Part of the registration is to receive an accreditation card, which entitles the athlete and the entourage to participate in all activities, see point 8.
- 4. **Sports Emil Open** athletics, swimming, bocce, boccia, table tennis, archery, cycling, throw ball
- 5. Sports V4 Team Games Emil Open wheelchair basketball, futsal for the blind, ID field hockey, volleyball for the deaf
- **6. Transport** from the accommodation to the sports ground will be provided by the organizer, the announced transport schedule must be observed. In the case of your own transport to the sports ground, it is necessary **to observe the on-time arrival at the sports ground**.
- 7. Each sport will have a major technical meeting of coaches and staff on the opening day of the event (immediately after the opening ceremony, at approximately 6:30 pm), at which the heads of the delegations of the respective sports will receive all necessary instructions, including the start lists and competition schedule. Meeting will take place in Hotel International. Late requests for essential technical information and changes will be disregarded!
- **8.** For organisational and safety reasons, only athletes and their permitted companions have access to all sports venues, including assistance dogs. The athlete and his/her escort must present an accreditation card.
- **9.** Athletes are required to **compete with their own sports equipment or compensatory aids** if this is a condition for competing in a particular sport.
- **10. The timing** of each competition will be announced:
 - **10.1.** At the technical meeting (25 June 2025 at approx. 18:30)
 - **10.2.** Further according to the schedule of the sport
- 11. The format of competitive sports:
 - 11.1. **OPEN**
 - supports and motivates beginners;





- open to all individuals from the target group primarily beginners and those who have not
 yet participated in sports, regardless of whether or not they are registered in sports clubs,
 without the condition of registration in a national or international federation;
- by submitting your application you confirm that the competitor is medically fit and has some training experience in the sport in question in different types of sports competitions and at different performance levels;
- Evaluation (unless otherwise determined by the sport director) evaluation and advancement to the finals are based on the principle of relativity, allowing everyone to advance to the finals. The principle of relativity is based on an evaluation of actual performance in relation to the individual, which allows for an adequate rating in the disability category. The criterion for evaluation is approaching, achieving or surpassing one's own qualifying results in the finals. All competitors who have completed the qualifying event advance to the finals. All competitors who have passed the qualifying rounds advance to the finals the following day. The final groups will be formed according to the actual result. A more detailed explanation for each sport according to the maximum effort rule in qualification and finals will be explained for each sport at the technical meeting. The final standings will be decided by the result in the final;
- awards all participants of the final will be awarded with a given type of medal during the medal ceremony.

11.2. **MIXED**

- **It is a format** where an athlete and a non-disabled individual (coach, parent, volunteer, etc.) compete together as a pair or team;
- Promotes inclusion of people with disabilities;
- the condition of participation is enrolment in the OPEN format in the given sport;
- in the registration system it is necessary to indicate whether the athlete will compete with his/her own companion without disability or whether he/she accepts a sports partner from among the organizer's volunteers;
- Awards during the medal ceremony, all participants will be awarded a participation medal;
- more detailed explanation in the regulations of the sport.
- **11.** Each competitor can only register in one sport and in the mix of that sport.
- **12.** Each athlete participates **in the demonstration sports based** on his/her own decision and time availability. However, we recommend trying blind futsal, field hockey or tossball. Athletes and their escorts will be **familiarized with the rules of the sport.**





V4 Team Games Emil Open

- Running alongside the European Games will be the V4 Team Games Emil Open project, which brings team sports to the Games. On the upper field of the athletics stadium, you will have the opportunity to try out field hockey and blind futsal on Thursday and Friday. We highly encourage you to try out the sports.

Competition system: A competitor in the **OPEN** format may enter a **maximum of two events**.

> A competitor competing in two disciplines can have a maximum of one track and one field discipline!

> Qualifying competitions will take place on 26 June at the appointed time. The results of the qualification are the basis for the final groups. All competitors who have passed the qualifying rounds participate in the finals. The final competitions will take place on the following day, 27 June, at the appointed time.

Rating: **OPEN** format - see General Information, point 11

> MIXED format: the format, probably a pairs run, will be determined at the technical meeting on 25.6., given the interest and time possibilities, including the method of evaluation. Running only 1x - podium awards with medals of mix type

without ranking. Mixed format will take place on Thursday 26.6.

Rules: The race is run according to IAAF rules, except: walkers can choose to start from

blocks or without blocks.





It is necessary to maintain your own lane, in the 400 m race (walkers and wheelchair users) it is also necessary to maintain your own lane. The 800 m run goes directly to the curb. In the field events the competitor has 2 warm-up attempts and 3 timed attempts.

If 3 attempts in the qualification are invalid, the competitor advances to the final with the organizer deciding on the final group.

Note to coaches/staff: coaches are responsible for the timely arrival of the athlete (after warm-up) to the presentation in the CALL ROOM, i.e. no earlier than 15 minutes and no later than 10 minutes before the start of the discipline. Coaches do not have access to either the Convocation Room or the sports field.

The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the regulations and rules of Athletics if it is necessary to maintain the principle of fair play.

SWIMMING

Racecourse: Both swimming pools have a length of 25 m and 6-8 lanes, timed by a manual timer.

Disciplines: OPEN formát: 25 m, 50 m, 100 m (prsa, znak, kraul),

MIXED - 4 x 25m free relay, mandatory participation of minimum and maximum 1

swimmer without disability. Registration at the technical meeting.

Competition system: A competitor in the **OPEN** format may enter a **maximum of two events**.

The qualification competitions will take place on 26 June from 10.00 to 15.00. The warm-up is possible 10 minutes before the competition block. Disciplines are divided into 3 blocks (1st 25m race, 2nd 50m race, 3rd 100m race). The results from the qualification are the basis for qualification to the final groups. All competitors who have passed the qualifying rounds participate in the finals. The final competitions will take place the following day, 27 June, from 10.00 to 15.00.

Teams will be divided into pools by a random system, taking into account that each pool will have an equal distribution and representation of all groups - nationality, gender, age, type of disability. All team members will be together at one of the





pools. Teams will be informed of the pool designation no later than the technical meeting.

Rating: OPEN format - see General Information, point 11

Rules: Racing shall be in accordance with the current FINA rules, except: the possibility of

starting from the starting block or directly from the water. Start command by whistle, SP competitors by flag. The heats are common for all competitors i.e. for all

types of disability men and women together.

Remark: Since the current rule of relativity and maximum effort for the OPEN format (not

the championship), where the criterion for the award is to beat one's own results, is not very well established, it will be further explained at the technical meeting the

evening before the competition.

The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the regulations and rules of Swimming if it is necessary to maintain fair play, capacity of sports venues or the need to change the time schedule.

Game breakdown: OPEN format: players play without distinction of categories; players who did

not form pairs in the entry system were supplemented by other players by the organizer. The starting list will be published at the technical meeting. In any game, competitors cannot be changed during or before the game. In any game, competitors cannot be changed during or before the game. The last changes are

allowed during the technical meeting on the evening of 25.6.!!!

MIXED format: the team consists of 3 players, 2 of which are with and 1 without disability (registered escort or volunteer from the organizers). Mixed trios were formed by the players themselves in the registration system. The next registration will take place on site on 26 June. The competition will take place on 27 June. Only 1 team from each organization can be entered.





Competition system: OPEN + MIXED format - the game will be played for 15 min. (decided by the

organizer according to the number of teams) in a one-on-one system. Played game

will be finished.

Rating: OPEN format - is based on the sum of the results of both players as a team.

MIXED format - is based on the sum of the results of all 3 players as a team.

Abbreviated rules: OPEN, MIXED format

1. Teams choose the color of the ball.

2. The referee flips a coin - the winner has the jack and chooses a suit.

3. Throwing the pallina and the first ball (max 3 attempts - must throw between the half court line and the line 3 m from the end line); 3 times fail - the opponent throws in; again fail - the referee puts the pallina on the line 3 m from the end line).

4. Players may not step over the throw line.

5. The yellow ball (pallino) can be moved around the pitch by the bouncing balls.

6. The colour that has the balls further away from the pallina always takes the throw-in (referees show the players with a flag of the same colour as the team's balls).

7. All balls are won, and the winner throws in a pallina in the next set.

8. After all balls have been thrown out - both colours the same distance from the pallina - no points awarded.

9. Both suits are equidistant from the pallina during the game - the last player to throw continues.

10. Players may play in any order, except the one who throws in the pallina, who must then throw his ball first.

Violations:

1. overshoots

2. if someone throws his colour, if the opponent is to play - if the other balls have already been thrown in place, leave them there, move them if possible, return them to their original position. If they cannot be returned dead game.

Awarding of points:WIN 2 points, DRAW 1 point, LOSE 0 points. If the points are tied, the match will count. If there was a tie, the better score (more points recorded) counts.

Remark: The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the rules and regulations of Bocce if necessary to maintain fair play.

Sports hall: The playing area will consist of three match courts and one throwing court (Warm

Up), the playing floor is a decking. The hall facilities include changing rooms, rest areas where you can lie down, showers which will be equipped with shower chairs,

and a wheelchair accessible toilet.

Game breakdown: BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4, BC5 nobody registered

It is not necessary for athletes to have a medical classification. It is up to each player (his coach, doctor, boccia referee, etc.) to classify himself in the appropriate category according to his disability. As appropriate, the head referee at the sports ground will determine before the start of the competition which category the player falls into and reassign him/her if necessary. The only restriction on athletes is their age, which must be between 10 and 26 years of age.

If there is a situation of insufficient occupancy of some categories, we will proceed to merge the categories. We will take into account the performance of each category in the merger.

BC1 - In this division, players classified as CP1 or CP2 in the Worldboccia classification compete. Players may be assisted by one sports assistant who must remain in a designated area behind the throwing box. These assistants perform tasks such as: adjusting or stabilizing the playing cart, passing the ball to the player, rolling the ball (getting the desired shape).

BC2 - In this division, players classified as CP2 in the Worldboccia classification compete. Players cannot have a sports assistant during the game. Players may request an assist from an umpire during their playing time, only to hand them a dropped ball or when entering the court.

BC3 - In this division, players with very severe motor dysfunction of all four limbs, whether of cerebral or other origin, compete. Players are unable to operate a wheelchair and are dependent on the assistance of an assistant or electric wheelchair. Players are unable to exert a sustained grip and therefore use assistive devices. Each player is allowed an athletic assistant who remains in the throwing box, but must remain with their back to the playing area of the court and with their eyes averted from their own game.

BC4 - This division includes players classified under Worldboccia rules as BC4 - non-pasty disabled and BC4 players playing with their feet. Players cannot have a sports assistant during the game. Players may request assistance from an umpire during their playing time to pass them a dropped ball or when entering the court.

BC5 - players with a physical disability of three limbs, generally players who have a better physical profile and function than players in the BC2 and BC4 classification classes.





Competition system: Players who play by throwing balls with their limbs (BC1, BC2 and BC4) will be combined into one category called "Throwers" due to lower participation. This category will have basic groups from which the winners of the groups will advance to the elimination (semi-finals). The BC3 category will have one group where all players will play each other twice.

Each player is required to report to the Callroom 30 - 15 minutes prior to each of their matches. If a player fails to do so, his match will be forfeited by default, see Worldboccia rules.

Technical briefing:

On June 25, 2025, a meeting will be held between the team leaders and the Sports Site Coordinator, Head Referee and Tournament Director. At this meeting, the team leaders will register their players for the tournament and confirm the player's acceptance into the respective competition classes.

Evaluation: the top three athletes in each category will be awarded a medal.

Rules: The competition follows the official Worldboccia rules, downloadable here: https://www.worldboccia.com/about-boccia/rules/. Players' equipment will not be checked during the tournament. We trust that competitors will have technical equipment in a condition consistent with fairplay. No medical classification is required for this tournament.

Takeaway: Appropriate sports clothing and indoor (non-staining, light-soled) shoes for the entourage; clothes to be worn after the match. The player is required to wear a jersey (also in the locker room and convocation hall) during the match, including accreditation and starting number. Without these items, the athlete will not be allowed to participate in the match. A jersey is defined as a minimum of a shirt with the facility or country from which the player originates.

Note: The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the rules and regulations of Boccia if necessary to maintain fair play.

If a player does not have his/her own balls, it is possible to rent boccia sets from the organizer for the duration of his/her match.

In the BC3 category, we require that the player has a ramp operator who will not do this for another player in the same category.

The showers in the changing rooms will be adapted for wheelchair users (chairs) - in case of a problem, please communicate with the sports manager.





BOCCIA HALL MAP





On Thursday, the OPEN qualification will take place, when two rounds will be shot, in each round 3×5 arrows will be shot, i.e. 15 arrows per round and 30 arrows per qualification. The time limit for shooting 5 arrows is maximum 6 minutes. Volunteers will help with the arrows, if needed, and will also record the results and collect the arrows.

Additionally, if interested, there will be a MIXED qualifier on Thursday where a chaperone/volunteer can enter the race with a competitor. The MIXED qualifier will be shot at 4×3 arrows for each of the mix.

The final two OPEN races will take place on Friday:

The competitors will be divided into four groups according to their performance in the qualification and will compete for medals. The competition will be shot on 4×5 arrows.

Competitors will be divided into groups so that each group has a representative from each performance group and the groups will compete against each other for medals. The competition will be shot on 4×5 arrows.





Also on Friday, if interested, the MIXED finals will be shot. But here it depends on the number of entries. The division into competitions will be specified on Thursday according to the number of entries.

Entry to MIX will take place on Wednesday at the technical meeting or at the latest on Thursday before qualifying.

Rating: OPEN - see General Information, point 11

MIXED - evaluation of all participants (all disabilities) with a participation medal

The organizer reserves the right to change the game system according to the number of entries and to modify the game categories if necessary.
